



NOTICE OF A COMPETITION

to create

A PROCLAMATION FOR AN AUSTRALIAN REPUBLIC

Award \$ 470

Because 2016 is the centenary of the proclamation of the Irish Republic at the Dublin GPO on 24 April 1916, the Melbourne Celtic Club, through its Cultural Heritage Committee is holding a competition to write a Proclamation for an Australian Republic.

The Rules of the Competition:

1. To write in approximately 470 eloquent words a vision statement for the Republic of Australia (470 words being the length of the 1916 Proclamation at the Easter Rising in Ireland)
2. The competition is free to enter and open to all.
3. There is a limit of two entries per person.
4. Entries will be judged on broadly based aesthetic criteria and the quality and clarity of the writing; the judges' decision is not negotiable nor will correspondence be entered into.
5. Entries must arrive in hard copy and also be emailed by 5pm on Monday 29 February 2016. The address is Celtic Club Cultural Heritage Committee 316 Queen Street Melbourne 3000, Email info@celticclub.com.au and addressed to the Cultural Heritage Committee, Celtic Club
6. The total prize money shall be \$ 470.
7. The prize will be presented at an event organised by the Celtic Club on Saturday 19 March.
8. The winning entry and other commendable entries shall be considered for publication in Australian Irish journals, Club website etc.
9. The participants must be prepared to sign declarations that the work is original, and that the Celtic Club is free to use the proclamation at the prize-giving ceremony and for other forms of publication; on their website and in other publications as the need arises.
